IFR ceilings will settle in Saturday morning and we'll be cloudy with a few light showers possible thanks to the approaching cold front. Sunday will be cooler, but we'll still see highs near 70 under cloudy skies and perhaps a few more light showers. The front will finally clear the area by Sunday afternoon with cold air and gusty winds filtering in behind it. Monday and Tuesday will be cold, and we might even see our first freeze of the season! No hazards Monday and Tuesday other than gusty winds and LGT TURB.
