Subject: Direct Procurement Method (DPM) Household Goods (HHG) Routing Guidance – Andros Island, Bahamas (DODAAC: N63821)

Purpose: To establish authorized routing procedures for Household Goods (HHG) shipments to NUWC DET AUTECH, Andros Island, Bahamas.

Be Advised: All government cargo and HHG shipments must be routed through Cape Canaveral, Florida, for onward movement to AUTECH Naval Base, Andros Island, Bahamas. Shipments must include all required documentation: DD Form 1149, complete cargo inventory, SED (if applicable), TCN, TAC code, and on-island POC.

Delivery Requirements:

- All air, water, and motor cargo must be delivered to the above address with complete documentation.
- Improperly documented cargo may be refused.
- Cargo delivered before 1200 on Wednesday will be manifested for Monday vessel departure.
- Vessels arrive at AUTECH, Andros Island on Thursday.

Origin & Destination Routing:

- Origin: Cape Canaveral, FL – WPOE: 1R1
- Destination: Andros Island, Bahamas – WPOD: CB5
- DODAAC: N63821
- Final Forwarding To: Receiving Officer, NUWC DET AUTECH, Andros Island, Bahamas

- Mark For: Member's rank, full name, and last 4 digits of SSN

Unauthorized Routing Warning:

Shipments routed outside of Cape Canaveral may result in:

- Delays or seizure by Bahamas Customs
- Duty charges despite AUTEK's duty-free status
- Logistics failure due to terrain restrictions:
 - Narrow bridge unsuitable for government trucks
 - No local carrier access to base security
 - No off-base unloading capability

Authorized Mode of Transportation:

- DPM/HHG shipments only
- UB/HHG via air is not authorized

Alternate Routing (if no DPM contractor available):

Route via Code D / 2 (GOC) / 4 (OCONUS) using:

- Travel Orders
- TCMD for export via WPOE 1R1 → WPOD CB5

- Provide GBL, TCMD, Orders, DD1299 to hauler

- Drivers must schedule delivery via:
 - WHSE Ops: 321-853-6649
 - ALT POCs: 321-853-6742 / 6741

- **Upon arrival:**

- Report to Security Pass & ID (Hours: 0630–1400 M–F)
- Complete badging and inspection
- Escort to terminal follows clearance
- Delivery hours: 0800–1500 M–F (closed 1200–1300 for lunch)

Reminder: Shipments routed directly to Andros Island bypassing CCSFS may result in mission-critical delays and legal complications. Repeat violations must be escalated and corrected. All HHG shipments must originate from Cape Canaveral and follow SDDC/PPSO protocols.
