We are seeing widespread LIFR cigs and fog this morning, and I don't expect much improvement til 10-11L. No issues for the PM, but IFR returns for the N1 by 22L. Tomorrow looks similar, and Saturday will also start off IFR. Saturday PM, a cold front will spark showers and ISOLD TS during the PM period. A few showers could linger into the early portion of the N1, and I think cigs could also be stubborn. But come Sunday, it'll be alright. Skies will scatter out, and stiff NW winds will bring in a rush of cold air. Winds will be gusty Sunday AM-PM, flirting with warning criteria (G30kts) during the PM. Next week will get off to a cool but VFR start!
