Things are looking good out there today, and we'll warm up nicely this afternoon. A cold front will approach the area tomorrow, bringing in a low chance for ISOLD showers, mainly during the AM/PM periods. I think cig/vis should remain VFR. Be watchful for ICING conditions during the PM/N1 and again on Thursday AM behind the front. Also, winds will be gusty (G20kts) Thursday AM/PM. Friday looks hazard-free, but another front moves in Saturday. Again, I think cig/vis are OK, but there could be ICING conditions Saturday AM. The remainder of the forecast period will be VFR and NEG hazards.
