Subject: Small Packages through APOE Travis AFB via AMC Channel Missions

Purpose: Advise shippers on requirement for movement of eligible small packages destined to Pacific locations to include Alaska and Hawaii.

Be Advised: Travis AFB receiving approximately 5,000 shipments of small packages per month. Due to high volumes of cargo delivered to Travis AFB with limited floor space, Air Mobility Command is reminding all transportation offices and shippers to not ship international small packages under 50 lbs. (except for packages which cannot be transported via NGDS/*other commercial air transportation methods*) for onward movement in the AMC channel. Shipping small packages via AMC channel creates an unnecessary backlog at Travis AFB, and in turn delays movement of all DoD cargo.
