Subject: Clearance Requirement for Outsize Cargo thru Aerial Port of Embarkation (APOE) Travis AFB

Purpose: To notify shippers of limitations at the 60th Aerial Port Squadron, Travis AFB, during reduced organic channel airlift into USINDOPACOM.

Be Advised: From 21 February 2026 to 01 May 2026, storage and building space in the MMHS and outsize cargo area will be limited due to a reduction of organic airlift other than CRAF missions, during a surge of higher priority contingency operations requiring most available C-17 and C-5 airframes. 60th APS Cape Forecasting office requires that cargo exceeding "any" of the following dimensions be cleared by the Aerial Port before shipment:

Length: 217"

Width: 88"

Height: 96"

Required Information for Clearance:

- TCN (Transportation Control Number)
- Destination/Aerial Port of Debarkation (APOD)
- Piece count
- Weight
- Length
- Width
- Height
- Nomenclature

Capability Forecasting will provide the ACA/Shipper with a clearance number when approved.
