Subject: MCAS Yuma, Arizona Safe Haven and Receipt Shutdown/Pause of Explosive Cargo

Purpose: To advise shippers and carriers on the Shutdown/Pause receipt of Explosive Cargo.

Be advised: Starting at 0600 on 13 March 2026 to 2000 on 14 March 2026, MCAS Yuma Arizona will begin implementing Air Show explosive safety precautionary measures. It is required that MCAS Yuma Arizona does not receive any explosive loaded vehicles during the requested times and dates in order to comply with required explosive safety measures.
