**Subject:** Movement of DoW Cargo destined to installations within United States Air Forces Central Command (AFCENT) AOR

**Purpose:** Provide Mission Impaired Capability Awaiting Parts (MICAP) and General Cargo shipping instructions for all Air Force Shipping Activities.

**Be Advised: Due to current operations and the air space being closed in the AOR until further notice, all commercial shipments consigned to the DODAACs identified in paragraph 2 below must utilize the Air Mobility Command's channel airlift system, and those in paragraph 3 must utilize ARTRANS door-to-door surface or sealift modes.** This advisory takes effect immediately and supersedes all previous customer advisories for Movement of DoW Cargo destined for all installations within AFCENT.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

1. **High Priority Cargo:** A part or piece of equipment that is needed in an urgent manner to satisfy existing Non-Mission Capable Supply (NMCS). Please use discretion when identifying the level of need for a part or piece of equipment. Due to real world events, AFCENT has implemented the following limitation for DoW shippers: **effective immediately, "Transportation Priority: 1 RDD: 999, MICAPs, and/or TP-1/TP-2 cargo designated with Project Codes: 9AL, 9AK, 9AJ"** for the following locations will be shipped via Military Air to the respective APOD.
2. Location-specific routing instructions for military air are as follows:
  - a. United Arab Emirates: All airlift eligible cargo destined for DoDAACs FB4811 (Al Dhafra Air Base) and FB4856 (War Reserve Material Abu Dhabi) will be shipped to APOD DHF.
  - b. Kuwait: All airlift eligible cargo destined for DoDAACs FB5820 (Ali Al Salem Air Base) and FB5819 (Al Jaber Air Base) will be shipped to APOD KEZ.
  - c. Saudi Arabia: All airlift eligible cargo destined for DoDAAC FB4863 (Prince Sultan Air Base) will be shipped to APOD AKH.
  - d. Qatar: All airlift eligible cargo destined for DoDAACs FB4804 (Al Udeid Air Base) and FB5897 (War Reserve Material Al Udeid) will be shipped

to APOD IUD.

- e. Jordan: All airlift eligible cargo destined for DoDAAC FB5808 (Muwaffaq Salti Air Base) will be shipped to APOD SQX.
- f. Jordan: All airlift eligible cargo destined for DoDAAD FY4934 (King Faisal Air Base) will be shipped to APOD AQR.
- g. Israel: All airlift eligible cargo destined for DoDAAC FY4915 (Ovda IAF Base) will be shipped to APOD VDA.
- h. Israel: All airlift eligible cargo destined for DoDAAC FY4916 (Nachal Soreq), FY4917 (Ben Gurion), FY5431 (Nevatim Air Base Arad), and FY5503 (Herzliya Pituah) will be shipped to APOD TLV.

- 3. **General Cargo TP-3:** will be shipped via surface (motor/line-haul) or sealift and must be booked through ARTRANS on door-to-door terms.
