Subject: Guidance on Transportation Disruptions, Inquiries, and Procedures for Shipments within the CENTCOM Area of Responsibility (AOR)

Purpose: This advisory provides clarifying guidance and consolidates key procedural points from the Defense Transportation Regulation (DTR) relevant to operations within the U.S. Central Command (CENTCOM) Area of Responsibility (AOR).

Be advised: All transportation offices (TOs), including Service/Agency, DLA, Traffic Management Offices, Division Transportation Officers (DTOs), DoW Contractors, and DCMA, that support CENTCOM by shipping to, from, or between locations within the CENTCOM AOR must update their Transportation Facilities Guide immediately whenever critical operational changes occur and adhere to the following procedures:

- **Emergencies and Transportation System Disruptions** (DTR, Part II, Chapters 201 & 301): When a Department of War (DoW) activity experiences an emergency or anticipates a transportation disruption, the responsible TO will immediately notify the CENTCOM CCJ4. CCJ4 will assist in acquiring the necessary authorization to mitigate the disruption.
- **Customer Advisories** (DTR, Part II, Chapters 201 & 301): All requests for advisories concerning CENTCOM operations must be routed through the respective component headquarters to CCJ4 for submission to ARTRANS.
- **System Outages & Status** (DTR, Part II, Chapters 201 & 301): In the event of a systems outage, follow your Service/Agency's contingency plans and notify your component. All TOs **will reflect changes** in the to their installation shipping and receiving operational status in Transportation Facilities Guide (TFG) **as they occur**.
- **Order of Precedence** (DTR, Part II, Chapter 202): Contact your Service/Agency headquarters or respective CENTCOM component for clarification on order of precedence.
- **Shipper Assistance** (DTR, Part II, Chapter 203): Any shipper needing assistance with shipping to, from, or between CENTCOM locations should contact their Service/Agency headquarters, CENTCOM component command, and/or CCJ4.
- **Transportation Protective Service (TPS) Shipments** (DTR, Part II, Chapter 205): Direct questions regarding TPS movements to your Service/Agency headquarters or CCJ4.

- **Customs and Agriculture** (DTR, Part V, Chapter 512): Direct all questions on customs and agriculture processes and policies in the CENTCOM AOR to CCJ4.

General Information: This advisory serves as a quick reference for clarification and is not a substitute for the DTR. All shippers and transportation personnel must review the DTR in its entirety to ensure full compliance.
