BASIC ORDERING AGREEMENT SUSTAINMENT TRACK (BOAST)

The BOAST program is a 5-year acquisition vehicle consisting of a pool of over 100 pre-qualified vendors holding Basic Ordering Agreements (BOAs) in direct support of TACOM Integrated Logistics Support Center (ILSC) Class IX supply requirements.

KEY BENEFITS

- Accelerated PALT: Pre-established terms and streamlined templates reduce time to award.
- Enhanced Competition: Drives rapid, effective competition among a large, capable vendor pool.
- Reduced Admin Burden: Eliminates repetitive negotiations and administrative processes for Government and Industry.
- Dynamic Industrial Base: A continuous on-ramp allows new, qualified vendors to join at any time.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The **BOAST** (basic ordering agreement sustainment track) program is a 5-year acquisition vehicle consisting of a pool of over 100 pre-qualified vendors holding Basic Ordering Agreements (BOAs) in direct support of TACOM Integrated Logistics Support Center (ILSC) Class IX supply requirements.

- Vehicle Type: Basic Ordering Agreement (BOA)
- Period of Performance: 5 Years (April 3, 2026 – April 3, 2031)
- Vendor Pool: 100+ established BOA holders (Continuous On-Ramp active)
- Acquisition Strategy: Streamlined competitive orders utilizing FAR Parts 12, 13, and 15.

SCOPE: CLASS IX SUSTAINMENT

BOAST procures repair parts and components for the maintenance support of all Army equipment (excluding medical-peculiar items). The scope encompasses all Class IX subclasses:

A – Air	L – Missiles
B – Ground Support Materiel	M – Weapons
D – Administrative Vehicles	N – Special Weapons
G – Electronics	T – Industrial Materiel
K – Tactical Vehicles	X – Aircraft Engines

OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCIES

THE BOA: Establishes the foundational set of clauses applicable under FAR Parts 12, 13, and 15 that may be invoked on future orders. (Note: The BOA is not a contract and contains no funded requirements.)

THE ORDER: Streamlined Requests for Order Proposals (RFOPs) are competed among the BOA pool, invoking only the clauses applicable to that specific requirement.

AGILE EVALUATION: Rapid competitions utilizing Price Only, Lowest Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA), or Best Value Tradeoff strategies.
