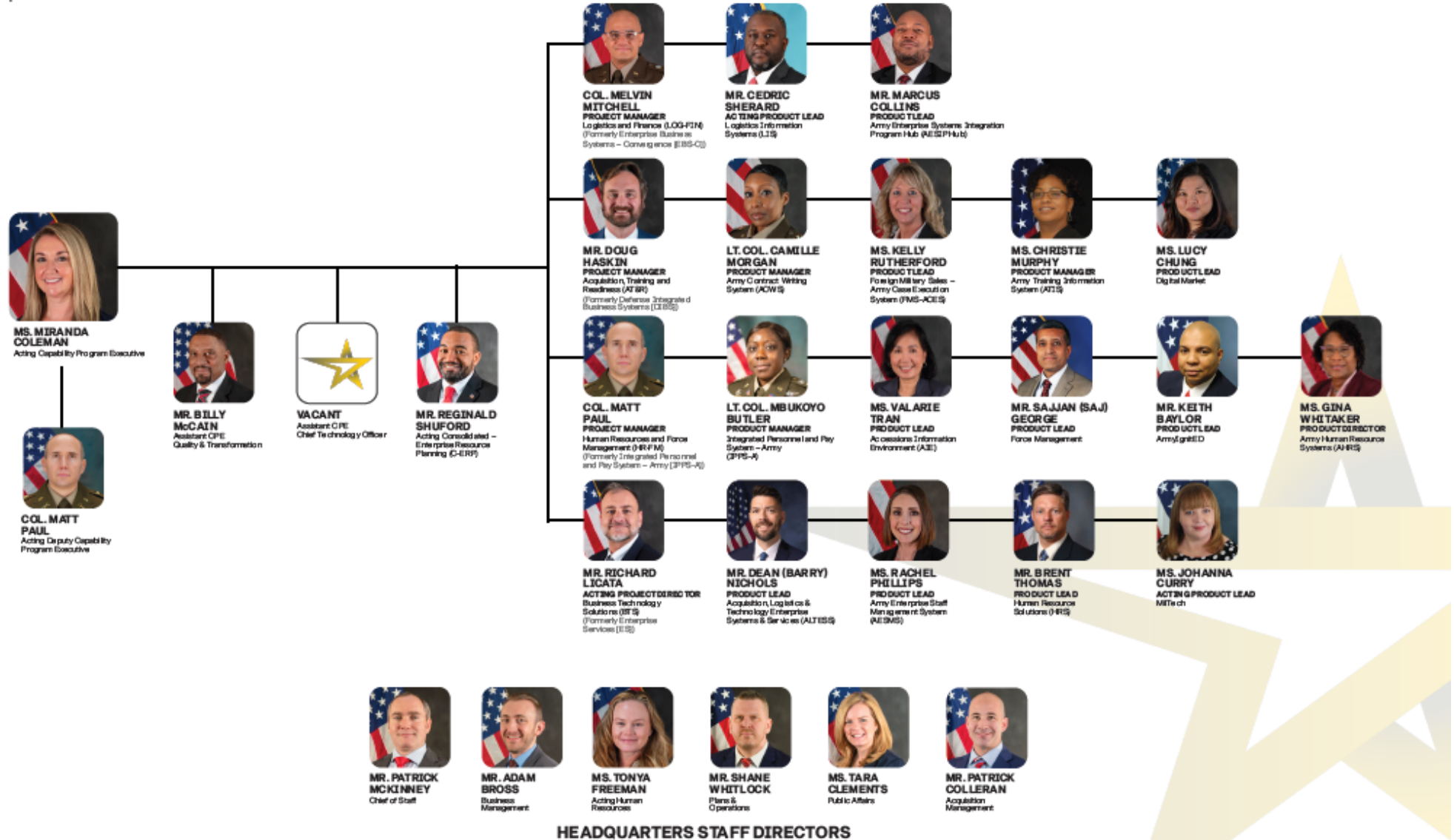

Functional alignment is the foundation of our success.

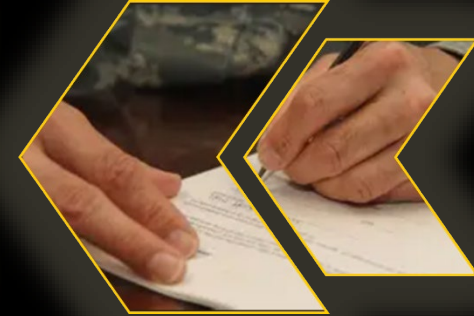


Contract Transformation

- Awarding 120 days before effective date disincentivizes protests (consider Bonafide need)

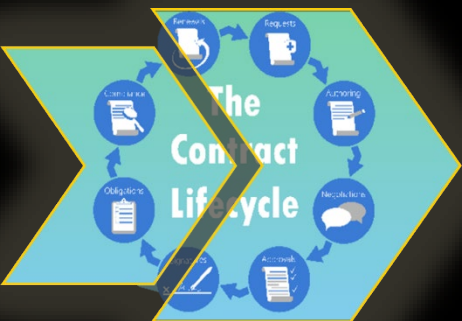

ENTERPRISE CONTRACTS

We keep buying the same things from the same vendors at different prices and terms. This doesn't make sense! Let's work smarter, not harder.



- Consolidated 138 contracts to 15 enterprise contracts in the last 8 months (90% reduction)
- Pre-negotiated terms (i.e., data rights) accelerate ordering to just days
- Range pricing has potential savings of up to \$18B
- Eliminates prime "pass-through" costs, saving 30%+
 - One contract saved \$303M alone
- Saves >\$146M annually in internal management costs
- Annual spend discounts
 - One contract could be up to \$1B
- Increases transparency and leverages volume for deeper discounts
- We have 60+ in the pipeline
 - Prioritizing based on impacts
- Still requires competition at the order level outside of what was consolidated





ARMY OPEN SOLICITATION UPDATES

Background

ACC-APG has issued the **Army Open Solicitation (AOS)**, which utilizes multiple solicitation authorities to include Commercial Solutions Openings and Broad Agency Announcements and is available to fulfill Army requirements using both FAR- and non-FAR-based awards.

- **22 calls for solutions**
- **Award Volume:** 18 total awards since May 2025
- **Processing Time:** 43-day average time to award

Two Methods


Active Capability Gap (ACG): Invites solutions from industry through a continuously open submission process

Calls for Solutions: Allows Army organizations to issue discrete calls to industry to address a specific objective or problem set

ACG Update

- Ongoing Army restructure delayed intended response times
- Reformatting internal processes to streamline
- Mission partners will complete Phase 1 tech evals of all backlog to date in the next month
