Acquisition, Training and Readiness



Doug Haskin assumed the role of project manager, Acquisition, Training and Readiness (AT&R) at U.S. Army Capability Program Executive Enterprise Software and Services (CPE ES2) in July 2025. In that position, he is charged with overseeing the team that develops, acquires, integrates, deploys and sustains enterprise-wide financial and procurement and training management capabilities that enhance readiness and modernization for the Army.

Before joining AT&R, Haskin served as the product manager for Aerial Enhanced Radars, Optics, and Sensors at Fort Belvoir, Virginia since 2022. In this capacity, he led a product office spread over three geographic locations delivering aerial intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance payloads to the Army.

In 1998, Haskin started his federal career as a commissioned Army officer. After serving five years on active duty, he transitioned to an Army civilian career, serving in three different program executive offices over the next 20 years: Command, Control and Communications – Tactical; Intelligence, Electronic Warfare and Sensors; and Enterprise Information Systems.

Prior to his last assignment, Haskin served two years in the Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition, Logistics and Technology supporting the Deputy for Acquisition and Systems Management as the team chief for acquisition policy. He also previously served as the product lead for the Army's Computer Hardware, Enterprise Software, and Solutions program, the deputy project director for Enterprise Services and the deputy product director for Transportation Information Systems at Program Executive Office Enterprise.

Haskin's education includes a Bachelor of Science degree in computer science from the U.S. Military Academy, as well as Master of Science degrees from the Naval Postgraduate School and the Eisenhower School for National Security and Resource Policy. He also completed the Senior Acquisition Course while attending Senior Service College at the Eisenhower School at Fort McNair. He holds advanced Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act certifications in Program Management and Life Cycle Logistics.

Haskin's awards and recognitions include two Superior Civilian Service Awards and the Commander's Award for Civilian Service. He was selected as a Federal Computer Week Rising Star in 2010. While serving as an active-duty Army captain deployed to Operation Enduring Freedom, he earned the Bronze Star award. ⬠
