THEIR LEADERS ARE TRAINED IN SHOW PRODUCTION AND MARKETING. USASOM GRADUATION CEREMONIES HAVE A BIT MORE FLARE THAN YOUR AVERAGE AIT. WITH THE SERGEANT MAJOR OF THE ARMY PRESENT TO HAND OUT DIPLOMAS, GRADUATES PRACTICED AND PRACTICED BEFORE THE BIG NIGHT. SGM CHANDLER'S PRESENCE WAS APPRECIATED.
