
Mission, Responsibilities and Programs & Initiatives

<u>Mission</u> -- OPMG Policy and Plans Division leads long-range policy development, planning, integration and assessment which inform resource allocation, program management and PMG decision making

Responsibilities and Programs

- Operationalize the MP Force 2020 Strategic Plan (STRATPLAN)
- Execute the Operational Management Meeting (OMM) process
- Manages OPMG equities in Army cyclic planning requirements including:
 - o Army Campaign Plan (ACP) input
 - Army Campaign Support Plan (ACSP) input
 - o Regional Alignment of Forces (RAF) and Security Cooperation working groups
 - o Army Posture Statement input
- Coordinates OPMG, Army, DoD policies for all roles and responsibilities of the PMG
- Maintains situational awareness of and appropriate participation in the HQDA G-3 Plans Process as
 well as Peacekeeping and Stability Operations Institute (PKSOI), Army Capabilities Integration Center
 (ARCIC), Irregular Warfare / Security Force Assistance (IW/SFA) Working Group and other OSD efforts
 affecting the MP Corps and Policing
- Fosters two-way support / communication to / from MP Corps Fellowship program participants
- Supervise / oversee academic and Joint, Interagency, Inter-governmental and Multi-national (JIIM) strategic outreach
- Coordinate review / input of NATO Standard Agreements
- Army Crime Victimization Survey

Initiatives

- Partner with the Department of State to synchronization USG responses to Policing and Corrections requirements in High Threat areas
- Assisting in the development of Policy with OSD Irregular Warfare / Security Force Assistance (IW/SFA)
 Working Group for the synchronization of Transitional Policing efforts
- Seek new broadening opportunities for MP Officers and NCOs with professional Policing, Investigations, Corrections and Security Agencies, Organizations and Institutes of Higher Learning.
- Maintains the OPMG publications priority list for use at The Army Publishing Agency
- Participating in HQDA, RAF, ACP and ACSP WGs to integrate PMG and MP STRATPLAN priorities and equities
- Integrating MPs into an ARSOF Advisory Detachment that will assist with planning and assessing police and criminal intel needs for SOF / GPF integration and partnership with state and ministerial police and non-military internal security forces
- Developing a Military Police Capabilities Senior Leader Handbook for Army Service Component Command and Geographic Combatant Command Provost Marshal's, and Army plannersSponsor professional studies and surveys on the effects of crime on the Army's mission, families and facilities
- Review war plans, OPLANS, etc. for MP equities and recommend updates and changes as necessary
