

Mr. Tony DeGusipe Deputy Assistant Product Manager, Increment 2 Logistics Modernization Program



Mr. Tony DeGusipe currently serves as the Deputy Assistant to the Logistics Modernization Program (LMP) Increment 2 Assistant Product Manager. In this role, he supports the planning and implementation of the LMP Increment 2, which will expand on Increment 1 to address Shop Floor Automation (SFA), Automatic Identification Technology (AIT), Expanded Ammunition (AMMO) requirements, strategic Army business transformation goals, and specific Department of Defense (DoD) directives, such as Item Unique Identification (IUID). As part of Increment 2, which will add approximately 9,000 new users and provide 5,000 existing users with additional functionality across the Army Materiel Command (AMC), he is responsible for supporting Business Process Reengineering (BPR), completion of DoD 5000.02 acquisition documentation,

and Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) integration strategies.

Mr. DeGusipe joined the LMP Product Management Office (PMO) in 2012 and served in a variety of technical and management positions overseeing the LMP Increment 2, including AIT and Tooling Lead, Site Infrastructure Lead, and Hardware and Software Procurement Lead. Prior to joining the LMP PMO, he served as Director, Fleet and Logistics Strategy for QinetiQ-North America. He also previously served as a federal government employee as the Lead Program Integrator for the Aviation Logistics Enterprise – Platform (ALE-P) program at Redstone Arsenal in Huntsville, AL. He is a 25-year Army Veteran and Combat Veteran, serving, among other posts, at Headquarters, 82nd Airborne Division as the Division Aviation Maintenance Officer and Supervisory Maintenance Test Pilot for the AH-64D Longbow Attack Helicopter, and at Headquarters, Department of the Army G-4 as the Lead Maintenance Integrator (legacy and ERP systems). Mr. DeGusipe has implemented many logistics capabilities to various levels of the Army to include Special Operations and Special Operations Aviation Activities.

Mr. DeGusipe holds a bachelor of science from Excelsior College, Albany, NY, and has earned numerous military and civilian certifications, including the Army Air Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (3), and Department of the Army Staff Badge. In 2006, the Army Aviation Association awarded him the Order of St. Michael, Bronze Award. He also earned multiple Defense Acquisition University (DAU) Certifications: Level II – Intermediate Program Management; Level I- Information Resources Management; and Level I – Funding of System Acquisition Management. He also completed certification to become a Federal Aviation Administration Commercial Rotary Wing Pilot (VFR/IFR).
