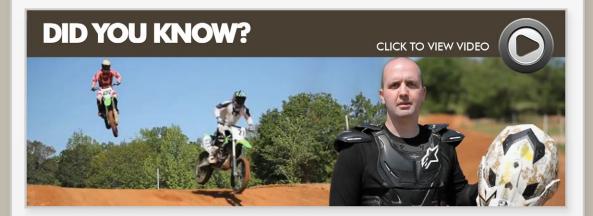
BETTER SAFE THAN SORRY
