- 2. To foster interest in USAG Daegu safety programs and to properly recognize organizations and individuals for their contributions and enhancements to the USAG Daegu Safety Program.
- 3. Directors / Commanders will recognize the following individuals of their units / activities with a certificate of Achievement in Safety IAW USAG Daegu Pam 385-1;
- a. Leaders or supervisors of an activity who have gone 12 consecutive months without an on-duty lost-time injury.
- b. Army Motor Vehicle drivers who have driven 12 consecutive months without an accident, injury, or traffic violation.
- c. Employees working within industrial/warehouse areas who have performed their assigned duties for 12 consecutive months without an accident/injury.
- d. Civilians employees who have maintained an accident/injury free work record for a 5-year period.
- e. Any employee who has made a significant contribution to the US Army Garrison Daegu Safety Program.
- 4. Nominations for awards will be submitted to the Safety Manager to ensure they are properly documented and submitted through the chain of command.
- 5. The rating supervisor will give favorable consideration to safety award winners for eligibility of the Sustained Superior Performance Award (SSPA) or Outstanding Performance Rating (OPR) in annual performance appraisals of employees. Include an appropriate record of awards in the individual's official personnel folder, or records jacket.
