SUBJECT: US Army Garrison (USAG) Daegu Policy Letter #97, Smoking Policy for Army Family Housing and Unaccompanied Housing

### 1. References:

- a. Department of Defense (DoD) Directive 1010.10, Health Promotion and Disease/Injury Prevention, 22 August 2003.
  - b. AR 600-63, Army Health Promotion, 14 April 2015.
- 2. Purpose. To provide additional guidance on smoking in Army Family Housing (AFH) and Unaccompanied Housing (UH) within the U.S. Army Garrison Daegu (USAG Daegu) area of responsibility.
- 3. Applicability. This policy applies to all military and their family members and visitors.

# 4. Definitions:

- a. Tobacco: Includes cigarettes, cigars, cigarillos, smokeless tobacco and/or electronic cigarettes, inhaled tobacco, and other tobacco products designed for human consumption.
- b. Environmental Tobacco Smoke (ETS): Also referred to as secondhand or passive smoke. Exhaled and/or side-stream smoke emitted.
- c. Common Space: Any space within a building that is common to occupants and visitors. These areas include but are not limited to: corridors, laundry rooms, stairways, elevators, lobbies, restrooms, playgrounds, and dayrooms.
- 5. DoD Policy: This Command's position on smoking is in accordance with DoD policy which is to:
- a. Protect all USAG-Daegu personnel from health hazards caused by exposure to tobacco smoke.

b. Designate reasonable outdoor accessible smoking areas, whenever possible, away from common spaces.

## 6. General:

- a. Use of tobacco products impairs readiness, whereas readiness is enhanced by a tobacco-free environment.
- b. Smoking is prohibited in <u>all</u> government owned and leased housing. Smoking in common areas such as hallways, stairwells, elevators, balconies, and within 50 feet of multi-family buildings is prohibited.
  - c. Smoking is prohibited in all unaccompanied housing.
- d. Facility managers and building coordinators will ensure that outdoor designated smoking areas will be at least <u>50 feet</u> from common points of ingress/egress and will not be located in areas that are commonly used by non-smokers. These smoking areas will have appropriate trash receptacles available and will be properly policed. Appropriate smoking signs will be posted.
- e. Smoking electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes) is not permitted in any location where smoking of traditional tobacco products is prohibited.
- 7. Those violating this policy will receive a written warning. Please note that failure to abide by this smoking policy may be grounds for termination from AFH and moved offpost **without any Housing entitlements** for service members residing in government owned and leased housing. Violations of these same provisions by service members residing in unaccompanied housing may be subject to adverse administrative actions and/or punishment under the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ).
