Personal Protective Measures in Public Areas

Based on recent reports and trends in London, Nice, and Stockholm, where terrorists have used trucks to conduct attacks on civil gatherings or in market areas, all U.S. Service Members, Families, and Civilians are asked to remain vigilant and avoid civil gatherings. This advisory applies particularly to market areas in places such as Itaewon, Dongdaemun, and Namdaemun in Seoul, and other large market or open areas throughout Korea.

All personnel must maintain awareness of their surroundings, identify any activity that appears to be suspicious or out of place, and immediately report that activity to the local Korean National Police, local Military Police, or Counterintelligence Special Agents.

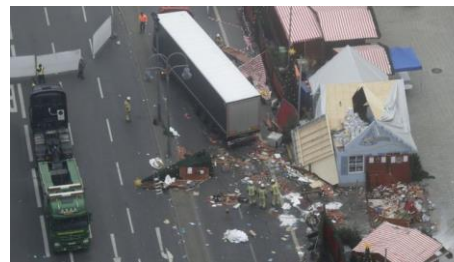

Tips for Protecting Yourself from Terrorism

- Maintain situational awareness of your surroundings at all times
- Identify items that seem out of place (unattended bags, luggage, pressure cookers)
- Remember descriptive details that may be useful to authorities
- Obey the orders of police/security personnel
- Take extra precaution with social media (i.e. avoid posting personal information)
- Maintain a low profile; try to blend in with the local populace
