# BEWARE OF DRONES (UAS)

*What can you do?*

Recent reporting has identified suspicious circumstances involving Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS), also known as unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV) or drones. It is common knowledge, drones have also be spotted globally following military convoys and military contracted supply vehicles. If observed, **report** all such incidents.

UAS can be used by Foreign Intelligence, terrorists, criminal organizations (including transnational organizations), and lone actors with specific collection or attack objectives.

### UAS-related threats may include:

- **Weaponized or Smuggling Payloads** – Depending on power and payload size, UAS may be capable of transporting contraband, chemical, or other explosive/weaponized payloads.
- **Prohibited Surveillance and Reconnaissance** – UAS are capable of silently monitoring a large area from the sky for nefarious purposes.
- **Collection Platforms**– UAS can be used to perform physical surveillance, target acquisition or collection of military activities.
- **Intentional Disruption or Harassment** – UAS may be used to disrupt or invade the privacy of other individuals.

Although, there is no assessed threat to the USFK community, it remains imperative that Service Members, Civilians, and Families remain **vigilant** and **report suspicious activity**.

*If you see anyone or anything suspicious or experience incidents where you feel you were surveilled or threatened, **report the incident** to your local Counterintelligence Special Agent (CI-SA), 501<sup>th</sup> MI Brigade, the Threat Awareness and Reporting Program (TARP) Hotline, Security Officers, or the Military Police.*
