# U.S. Embassy Seoul Security Message

**U.S. Embassy Seoul informs U.S. citizens that the Republic of Korea's Constitutional Court will announce its decision regarding the possible impeachment of President Park Geun-hye tomorrow (March 10) at 11:00 a.m.**

Demonstrations may follow the court's announcement, regardless of the outcome. Previously, massive demonstrations centered on Gwanghwamun Plaza (across from the U.S. Embassy), including the area between Seoul City Hall and Gyeongbokgung Palace.

Demonstrations may also occur at other locations throughout Seoul, to include in vicinity of Seoul Station or U.S. Installations, as well as in other Korean cities.

Demonstrations intended to be peaceful can turn confrontational and escalate into violence. Avoid areas of demonstrations and exercise caution if in the vicinity of any large gatherings, protests, or demonstrations.


Review your personal security plans, remain aware of your surroundings, including local events, and monitor local news stations for updates.

Be vigilant and take appropriate steps to enhance your personal security.

Report local threats to local Law Enforcement or a Counterintelligence Special Agent.

### *What can you do?*

*If you see anyone or anything suspicious or experience incidents where you feel you were surveilled or threatened, **report the incident** to your local Counterintelligence Special Agent (CI-SA), or the Threat Awareness and Reporting Program (TARP) Hotline.*

## General Personal Protective Measure Guidelines

### Commander's Information

**Antiterrorism (AT) Risk Management.** The process of systematically identifying, assessing, and controlling risks arising from operational factors and making decisions that balance possible adverse outcomes with mission benefits.

AT Risk Management is one of the five minimum elements of a successful AT program.

The end products of the AT Risk Management process shall be the identification of DoD elements and personnel that are vulnerable to the identified threat attack means.

In relation to the 10 March 2017 impeachment ruling, DoD personnel should develop a plan to minimize risk resulting from potentially large scale demonstrations. This includes avoiding areas of large gatherings and protests.

Additional information can be obtained by contacting your local Counterintelligence Office or Law Enforcement.

### Personal Protective Measures

Maintain situational awareness of your surroundings at all times. Pay particular attention to activity happening around you in order to identify anything unusual. If necessary, leave the area and report suspicious activity or behavior to local authorities. Travel with a buddy.

Take extra precaution with social media networks (such as Facebook, Twitter, and blogs) - avoid posting or providing personal information - remove all personal information or military affiliation currently on social media networks

Make sure your doors and windows are locked and exterior lighting function properly.

Check underneath your vehicle for anything suspicious.

Be prepared for an emergency that may require you to "shelter-in-place" or relocate on short notice. Make an emergency plan and understand what to do in each of these scenarios.

Maintain a "low profile." Try to blend in with the local populace through how you dress and your appearance. More specifically, do not wear military attire. Know the locations of safe havens and carry with you emergency telephone numbers and contact information.

### Antiterrorism Themes

#### ***Anticipate***

Anticipate threats, make choices that reduce risk

#### ***Be vigilant***

Remain alert, note changing conditions and suspicious activities

#### ***Don't be a target***

Be anonymous, control access, be unpredictable

#### ***Respond and Report***

Respond appropriately, report suspicious or threatening activities
