
Anti-U.S. / Anti-Park Information Operations

An extensive quantity of anti-U.S., anti-President Park, and anti-South Korea leaflets were scattered across USAG-Yongsan in an apparent attempt by North Korea to influence and potentially subvert U.S. operations and activities through a printed media Information Operations campaign. These leaflets are seemingly aimed at supporting the anti-President Park movement. The leaflets do, however, identify and decry critical U.S. and ROK policy initiatives that are essential to strengthening the U.S.-ROK Alliance. Specifically, these leaflets demand an end to the deployment of THAAD, Counter-WMD technologies, which it names as JUPITER, the abolishment of the U.S.-ROK Operations Plan, and a halt to U.S.-ROK combined exercises.

Maintain Vigilance!

The amassed presence of these leaflets on the U.S. Installation in Seoul is purely coincidence, resulting from numerous North Korean balloons that launched in the early hours of 11 January 2017, and floated into South Korea due to favorable wind conditions. The propaganda aims to motivate further U.S.-ROK dissidence and provoke anti-U.S.-ROK movements. This propaganda is indicative of North Korea's goal to encourage anti-ROK-U.S. affiliates in South Korea to take shape against the U.S.-ROK Alliance. It remains imperative that U.S. Service Members, Families, and Civilians remain vigilant, and continuously monitor and report real world threats to their safety. Understand key indicators of a threat, and **ALWAYS REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY**. Remember, if you **SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING!**
