Renew your Henry Gate Access

Reminder! Soldiers, residents, and civilians wanting to enter the installation via the Henry Gate portal must first activate their CAC or Military Dependent Card with the Visitor Control Center at the JBM-HH Police Station. The process includes the registration of biometrics (finger prints) and limits users to one-year of entry through the gate. Make sure to note the date of registration, as you will need to renew one year following the

date. This privilege is currently only available to CAC and Military Dependent Card holders. Please make sure to check that your card itself is current, as expired cards will not be allowed entry at any gate.

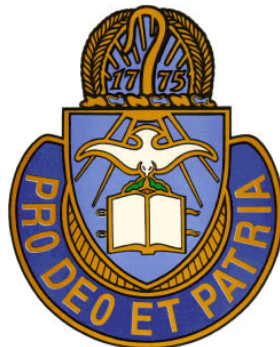
