PMV-2 Crash Claims One Soldier's Life

A 20-year-old Private 2 assigned to 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division (AASLT), Fort Campbell, Kentucky, died 27 August 2017 at 1500 local in Clarksville, Tennessee. The Soldier was operating his motorcycle when it collided with the rear of an SUV that was stopped in the left lane awaiting a left-hand turn. He suffered severe head trauma and was transported via life flight to a trauma center where he passed away the following day.
