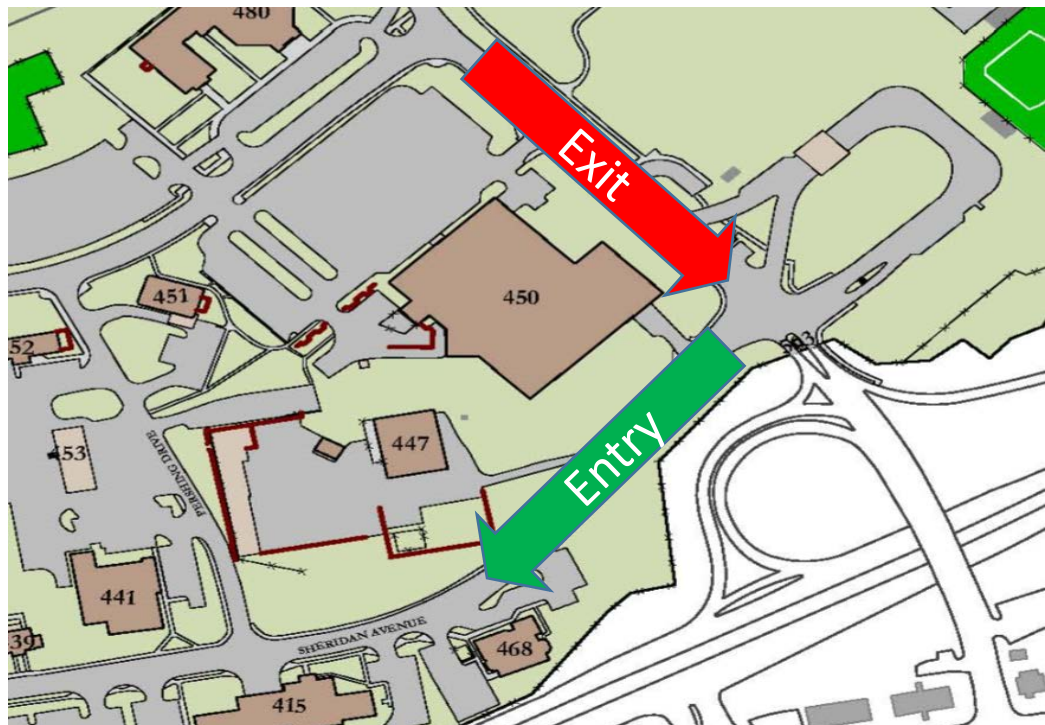
Details:

From 8:30 a.m. to noon – “Ten Steps to a Federal Job” – open to DoD ID card holders

From 1 to 2:30 p.m. – “The Stars are Lined Up for Military Spouses” – open to DoD ID card holders.

Special speaker is Kathryn Troutman, author and CEO for “The Resume Place, Inc.”

The workshop will cover such items as finding key words, core competencies, federal resume writing, who qualifies for Program S and EO 13473 for military spouses and how to get to a “best qualified” status, to name a few.

Army Ten-Miler Oct. 8

The Army’s 33rd annual Army Ten-Miler (ATM) is set for Sunday, Oct. 8, starting at 8 a.m. at the Pentagon. The Wounded Warrior and Wheelchair athletes start at 7:40 a.m. Runners must pick up their packets at the ATM Expo, Oct. 6 -7, held at the D.C. Armory located at 2001 E. Capitol Street, SE, Washington, D.C. Registration and packet pick up must happen at this time. There is NO race day packet pick up.

In preparing for the race, please be mindful that the following items are prohibited on the Race Course: Personal music devices (headphones,

MP3 players, iPods, etc.); edged weapons/cutting devices; any form of firearm; any explosive/flammable/com-bustible items, materials, or devices; aerosol sprays (pepper or mace); strollers or baby-joggers; inline or quad roller skates; skateboards; bicycles; pets/animals (except disabil-

ity or service canines); glass containers or bottles; and any vulgar or obscene flags/banners/signs or clothing/attire. No Backpacks.

Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training

This two-day interactive workshop Sept. 19 - 20 from 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. teaches gatekeepers to recognize when someone may have thoughts of suicide and how to create a plan to support their immediate safety. The training will take place in the Memorial Chapel.

Gatekeepers include individuals designated by commanders, in addition to Chaplains, Chaplain Assistants, SUDCC Counselors, FAP workers, AER Counselors, Medical/Dental Professionals, First Responders, Trial Defense and Legal Assistance Attorneys, Inspector General, and Red Cross workers. Renew your Henry Gate Access

Reminder! Soldiers, residents, and civilians wanting to enter the installation via the Henry Gate portal must first activate their CAC or Military Dependent Card with the Visitor Control Center at the JBM-HH Police Station. The process includes the registration of biometrics (finger prints) and limits users to one-year of entry through the gate. Make sure to note the date of registration, as you will need to

renew one year following the date. This privilege is currently only available to CAC and Military Dependent Card holders. Please make sure to check that your card itself is current, as expired cards will not be allowed entry at any gate.
