MEDEVAC Training Accident Claims One Soldier's Life

A Sergeant assigned to 1st Combat Aviation Brigade, 1st Infantry Division, Fort Riley, Kansas, died 12 September 2017 at 2230 local on Fort Hood, Texas. The Soldier fell approximately 50 feet while seated on a jungle penetrator during hoist operations for UH-60 Black Hawk MEDEVAC training.
