PMV-4 Mishap Claims One Soldier's Life

A Specialist assigned to the 10th Mountain Division, Fort Drum, New York, died 17 September 2017, in Ava, New York, at 0250 local. The Soldier was a passenger in a PMV-4 being operated by another Soldier in her unit who lost control of the vehicle while attempting to avoid a deer. The driver was not injured. Both Soldiers were wearing seat belts.
