SUBJECT: Command Policy #107, Licensing Explosives Storage Areas - Camp Humphreys

1. References:

- a. AR 385-10, The Army Safety Program, 27 November 2013.
- b. AK Reg 385-10, 8th Field Army Safety Program, 1 October 2010.
- c. DA Pam 385-30, Risk Management, 2 December 2014.
- d. DA Pam 385-64, Ammunition and Explosives Safety Standards, 24 May 2011 (RAR) 10 October 2013.
- 2. The Army Safety Program requires all organizations to comply with DA Pam 385-64 and, when outside the United States comply with host nation (HN), multinational, or U.S. explosives safety standards, whichever are more stringent, unless standards applicability is mandated by international agreement.
- 3. The Garrison Commander will license explosives storage for every separate location where he/she authorizes storage of Class V items on the installation. Explosives storage licenses can be more restrictive than the Department of Defense Explosives Safety Board (DDESB) explosives safety site plan upon which they may be based, but cannot exceed the Net Explosive Weight (NEW) or hazard classes of ammunition.
- 4. Licensing procedures are based on DA Pam 385-64. Units coordinate with installation elements (physical security, fire protective services and ammunition surveillance) to determine appropriateness of proposed sites, operating procedures and limitations using Camp Humphreys and Area III Safety Office, IMHM Form 46-R. Once coordination has been completed, forward the USAG-Humphreys Explosives License Packet to the Garrison Safety Office for review. The Garrison Safety Office will forward to the Garrison Commander for approval or disapproval.
