Grant Hall Open House Nov. 4

FORT MCNAIR, Washing-ton, D.C. – Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall announces its next quarterly Public Open House of Grant Hall's historic third-floor courtroom, located on the Fort McNair side of the Joint Base in southwest Washington D.C., from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday, Nov. 4. The courtroom is the site of the military tribunal, held from May through June 1865, of those thought responsible for the plot to assassinate President Abraham Lincoln.

During a 2009-2012 renovation of Grant Hall, which was originally part of Washington's Federal Penitentiary. from 1829 to 1868, the third floor of the building was restored to depict the courtroom as it appeared during the 1865 trial. Courtroom features were recreated based on artistic renderings and written descriptions of court proceedings. Some furnishings and artifacts on display are on loan from the production company of a 2011 historical film about the trial, and other artifacts and documentation are from the National Defense University Library.

Time to turn off AC/ turn on heat Residential area sodding continues

Jackson Ave/Lee Ave, Fort Myer:

October 23 - November 4

Residential change over from A/C to heat has begun! Our maintenance team will be calling all residents to schedule your unit's transition - you can also call the team directly at 703-696-2623 to get it scheduled. The team will be able to do up to eight quarters per day. Once all houses are changed over, the team will schedule filter changes and fan coil unit cleanings.

Please ensure that there are no items within three feet of your water heaters, furnace, pipes, etc at any time. Items too close to any of those appliances and their respective pipes are a fire and safety hazard and could delay the response of a team during an emergency. They could also hinder the team's ability to complete the change-over.

All residents are asked to water plants, lawns and especially newly sodded areas. Specifically for sod, it should be watered daily for up to three weeks after installation (should feel like a soaking wet sponge when watering is complete). After the initial three weeks, sod should be inspected/monitored and if browning is noticed, watered daily until green appears. Plants should be monitored daily. The ground around plants should feel moist. If watering is necessary, for plants, its best to water by hand at the base/trunk of the plant. Newly seeded areas should be watered daily until a full strand of turf is up. A sprinkler can be used, but monitor watering for puddling and run-off. Sprinklers are available at self-help in Bldg. 205 or by calling 703-696-2623.
