#### Arlington County Veterans Day speaker



## **Safety**

Safety Offices warn of fire extinguisher danger, recall

U.S. Army Intelligence and Security Command, Military District of Washington and Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall Safety offices report that some fire extinguishers, popular with consumers, may not work in an emergency. Some 134 models of push-button and plastic-handle extinguishers in the U.S. and Canada (made from 1973 through Aug. 15, 2017) are being recalled.

One death has been linked to problems with the extinguishers made by Kidde, according to a notice Nov. 2 from the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission.


