


Weekly Winter Safety Tip

Each year thousands of people get hurt shoveling snow. According to a study by researchers at the Center for Injury Research and Policy of The Research Institute at Nationwide Children's Hospital, 195,000 people were treated in the E.R. for snow-shoveling-related injuries in the years between 1990 and 2006. Depending on your age and fitness level, you should consult with your doctor before you shovel snow, especially if you've had a heart attack or other major medical problem.

On Jan. 1, 2018, there are a number of changes coming to your TRICARE benefit. This includes a change to the current TRICARE regions. In preparation for this change, enrollments in TRICARE health plans will be delayed while beneficiary files are transferred to the incoming regional contractors. The delay period, or an enrollment freeze, will begin on Dec. 1, 2017 and last approximately three weeks, or until the data transfer is complete.

Also, cost changes for TRICARE benefits transition from a fiscal year period to a calendar year period. This includes retirees and their family members in TRICARE Prime, TRICARE Retired Reserve, TRICARE Reserve Select and those in TRICARE Young Adult plans.
