The courtroom is the site of the military tribunal, held from May through June 1865, of those thought responsible for the plot to assassinate President Abraham Lincoln.

State of the Union helicopter landings

Tune in on Jan. 30th to watch the State of the Union. There will be multiple helicopter landings and takeoff at Fort McNair between 12 p.m. and 11 p.m. Tuesday January 30. Departures from Landing Zone 1, which is in front of the National War College on Fort McNair, will occur from 12 to 4 p.m. Arrivals and departures from Landing Zone 2, which is on the parade field with the flagpole on Fort McNair, will begin at 2 p.m. and continue until 11 p.m. Expect increased noise during these times.

Everyone must stay off of the field during landings and departures because of the strong rotor wash (rotor blades forcing air downwards), rushing air that can pick up and blow objects around. Because of the rotor wash, people are also advised not to park along 4th Avenue and 2nd Avenue adjacent to Landing Zones 1 and 2.
