NON-ARMY MANAGED ITEMS (NAMI) LOGISTICAL REASSIGNMENT (LR) GAINING ITEM MANAGER (GIM)

OVERVIEW

The LMP introduced Non-Army Managed Items (NAMI) functionality as part of Increment 2 Wave 2 to modernize other Source of Supply (SoS), Army-owned assets, enabling the Army Materiel Command (AMC) to support all supply mission needs at the tactical and non-tactical level for these assets. Specifically, NAMI LMP functionality enables the Army to maximize redistribution of existing Army inventory for Class 2, 3P, 4, and 9 items. Wave 3 NAMI adds the Logistical Reassignment (LR) process to the functionality in order to transfer accountable record balances, sales orders, and other data from NAMI to the gaining item manager (GIM).

Bottom line, NAMI LR GIM ensures all “before and after” reports and data displays of transactions are properly updated as accountable records of the GIM.



NAMI LR GIM Details

The LR business process ensures successful transfer of ownership and management responsibility of both consumable and non-consumable items. The LR process also includes the transfer of accountable record balances, sales orders, and other data from the Losing Item Manager (LIM) to the GIM.

The Effective Transfer Date (ETD) is used track the transfer of inventory ownership from NAMI to the Army GIM for Single Stock Fund (SSF) on-hand assets and generate DZC transactions (as defined by Army) outbound to the Forward Distribution Depot (FDD) sites.

The LR process has been divided into three periods of time based upon the ETD. These time periods will follow the LR initiation phase and are defined as pre-ETD, ETD, and post-ETD.

- The pre-ETD period commences on the date that the GIM and the date of transfer assignments are made, and published/disseminated to the LIM, and terminates at ETD.
- The ETD is the actual date of the reassignment.
- The post-ETD period begins immediately following the ETD and continues until the associated assets transfer is complete.

What NAMI LR GIM Does

- Displays all open sales orders for selected material
- Displays material movements performed in plant and date/time sequence of movements for improved tracking
- Closes out of sales orders with appropriate “Reasons for Rejection”
- Displays appropriate and up-to-date field entries to ensure proper coding and tracking of material
