UNITED STATES ARMY GARRISON YONGSAN-CASEY POLICY LETTER #26

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: USAG Yongsan Gate Restrictions

1. **PURPOSE:** This policy provides guidance and establishes restrictions for the use of Gate #1, 3 and 4 USAG Yongsan Post.

2. **APPLICABILITY:** This policy applies to all personnel either living in, or visiting, the Yongsan area.

3. **GENERAL:**

a. The physical construction of Gate One (1) causes severe traffic congestion. The below cited oversized/large vehicles are not permitted to use Gate One (1) on South Post. Alternate gates will be used for the oversized/large vehicles.

(1) Department of Public Works (DPW) vehicles (Dump Trucks, Cement Mixers, etc.)

(2) Contract vehicles over ½ ton (e.g. trash trucks, fuel trucks, buses, dump trucks, cement mixers, etc.)

(3) Tactical Vehicles

b. As a result of congestion at Gates Three (3) and Four (4), the following vehicles are not allowed to use Gate Three (3) on Main Post and Gate Four (4) on South Post. Specifically, they cannot enter nor exit through either of these gates between 0700 – 1900 hours. The overpass can be used as an alternate route.

Vehicles restricted from using Gates Three (3) and Four (4) are:

(1) Tactical Vehicles (except M998 cargo/truck carrier, M1025/1026 HUMMER, etc.).

(2) All vehicles over half ton (e.g. trash, fuel trucks, buses).

c. Commanders and supervisors must provide the necessary command emphasis to ensure this policy is disseminated and strictly adhered.

4. Violations of this policy should be reported to the Military Police (MP) Desk at DSN 724-3004/3008. Accordingly, the guidance and requirements outlined above will be strictly enforced by the MPs. Personnel who violate this Policy are subject to ticketing and other administrative sanctions as provided for in existing command policy and regulations.
